

# Sudbourne Primary School Nursery Admission September 2023 Information on additional hours and prices for 2023/24

Sudbourne Primary School offers flexible nursery provision. Parents and carers can choose from 4 attendance options (below) depending on personal preference. We will continue to provide part-time nursery places for families who want them but can also provide some full-time provision to meet the needs of families who need additional hours.

### Attendance Options

### Option 1 - Part-time place

3 hours per day, mornings or afternoons = 15 hours per week (free entitlement). Please note parents/carers must request mornings **OR** afternoons, not a mixture.

### Option 2 - Part-time place PLUS 2 additional sessions

5 mornings per week = 15 hours per week (universal free entitlement) **PLUS** 2 afternoons per week (12.30-3.30pm) free\* if eligible **OR** at the cost of £60.00 per week. Choose from **EITHER** Monday, Tuesday **OR** Thursday, Friday

# Option 3 - Part-time place PLUS 3 additional sessions

5 mornings per week = 15 hours per week (universal free entitlement) PLUS 3 afternoons per week (11.30-3.15pm) free\* if eligible or at the cost of £90.00 per week. Choose from EITHER Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday OR Wednesday, Thursday, Friday

# Option 4 - Full-time place

5 full days per week (8.40am-11:40am) =15 hours per week (universal free entitlement) PLUS 5 afternoons per week (12:30-3.30pm) free\* if eligible **OR** at the cost of £150 per week.

**free\*** - this refers to those with confirmed eligibility for 30 hours free childcare. To find out if you are eligible see <u>https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/</u>

# <u>Lunch</u>

Please note that children who stay for the whole day are asked to either bring a healthy packed lunch to school **or** buy a school meal @ £2.56\* per day unless you are eligible for means tested free school meals.



Parents/carers will have already applied for their preferred option from the above for academic year 2023/24 and offers have been made. Any changes to the requested attendance pattern for your child can only be done on a termly basis, Autumn, Spring and Summer. Parents/carers wanting to change the requested attendance pattern for their child should inform the school in writing as soon as possible by emailing admin@sudbourne.com

Invoices are issued at the start of each term and are payable in advance. Payment also can be made with childcare vouchers.
