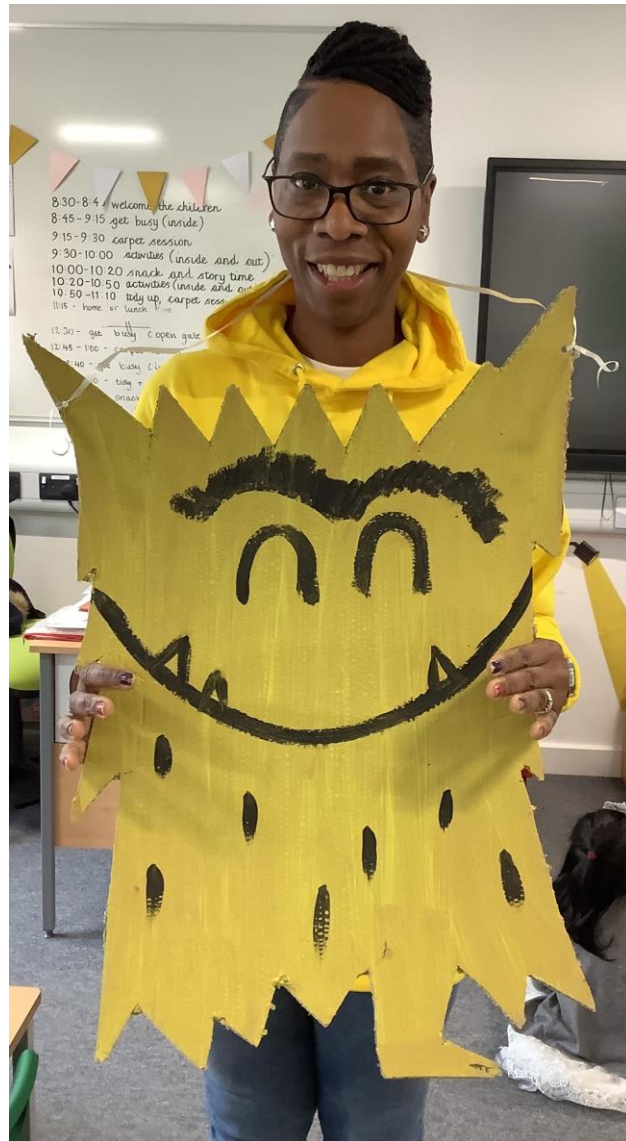


## World Book Day

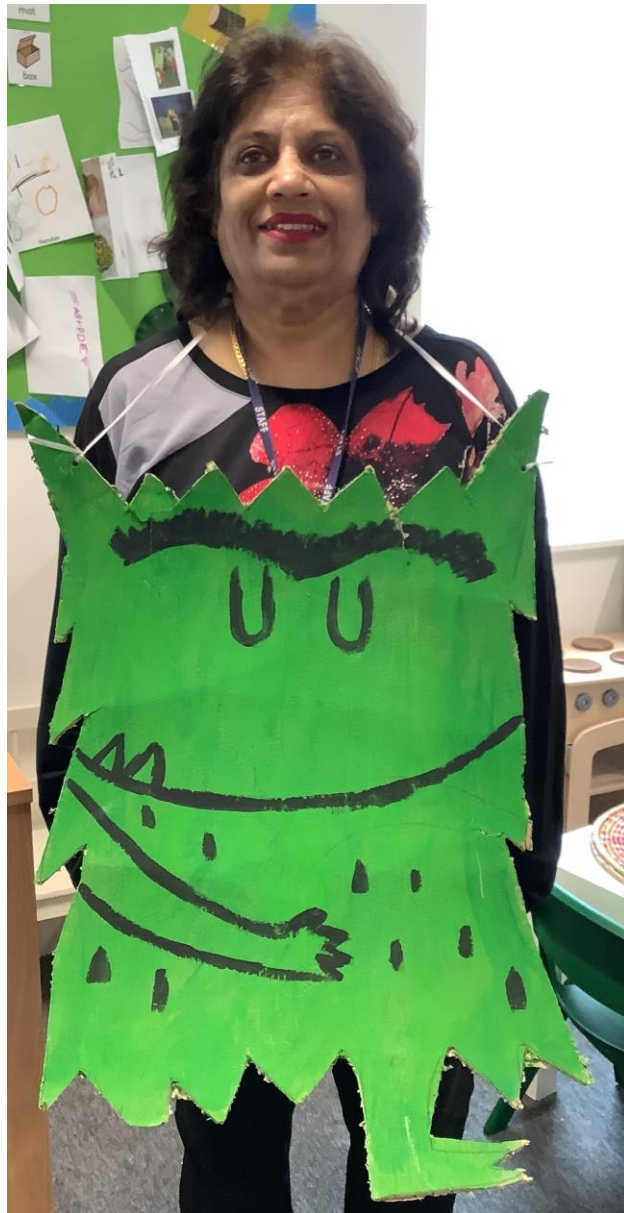

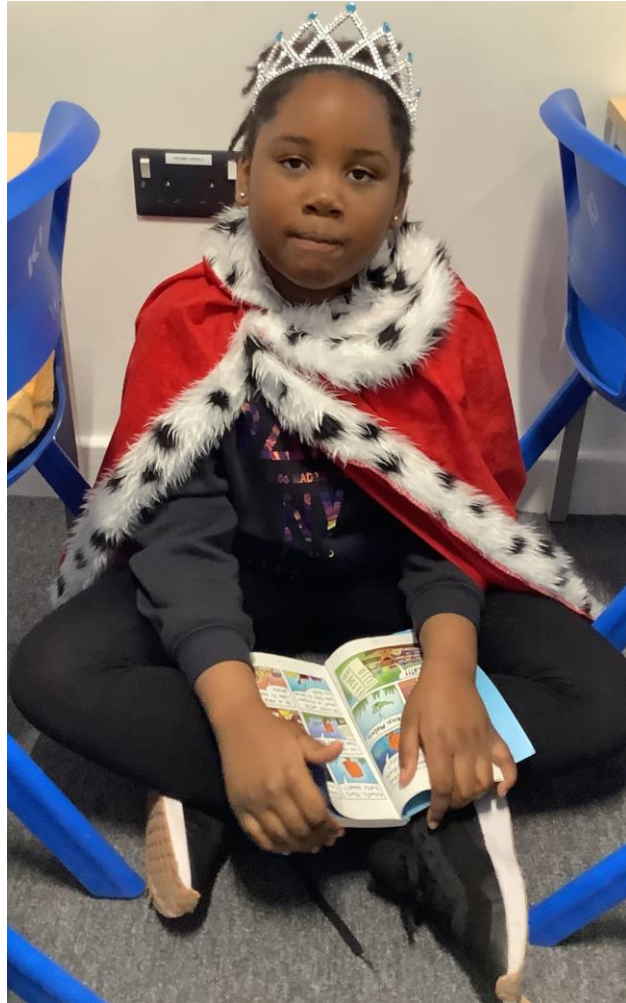
