### CHANGE OF PERSONAL CIRCUMSTANCES / PUPIL PREMIUM AND FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Have your personal circumstances changed recently? If so, your child may now be eligible for free school meals and pupil premium funding.

You can find out if your child is eligible quickly and easily by going to <https://pps.lgfl.org.uk/> which is a Free School Meal Eligibility Checker. If the checker confirms your eligibility, please inform the school office immediately.

Did you know, as a school we get extra funding for those children who are eligible for the Pupil Premium grant? Did you also know the government gives additional funding to schools for those children entitled to free school meals?

#### What is pupil premium funding?

Pupil premium funding from the government is given to schools to help pupils reach their full potential, regardless of their background or financial situation. It's provided for pupils who:

- Are registered for free school meals
- Have been registered for free school meals at any point in the past 6 years
- Are, or have been, in care
- Have parents in the armed forces

## **CHANGE OF PERSONAL CIRCUMSTANCES / PUPIL PREMIUM AND FREE SCHOOL MEALS continued**

On top of universal free school meals for children in Reception/Year 1 and Year 2, if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium they will also get:

- Reduced cost for school clubs
- Reduced cost for the Year 6 residential trip
- Extra funds for the school to buy resources to support the children
- Extra funds for the school to employ more staff to support the children
