IMPORTANT INFORMATION: SCHOOL MEALS FOR YEAR 2 PUPILS WHO WILL START YEAR 3 IN SEPTEMBER 2018

If your child is currently in Year 2, they will have been receiving a free school meal regardless of their personal circumstances (as part of the government's Universal Free School Meals initiative for all infant school children). **Please note that this will cease when your Year 2 child begins Year 3 this September 2018, which will mean that you will be required to pay £2.40 per meal from September 2018 onward (unless you are eligible for means-tested free school meals),**

This is a reminder to return your form, please. We have had very few returned so far and the deadline was Wednesday 20th June. On this form, you must indicate if you want your child to continue receiving a school meal (at the costs of £2.40 per meal) or if you will provide them with a packed lunch each day. **Please complete this form regardless of whether your child is changing their current meal option or not, so we can update our records accordingly and ensure we order enough food from our school meal caterers.**

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

NB: Please note also that juniors **start at an earlier time of 8:45am** (and not 9:00am). They finish at the same time of 3:15pm.

CLASS LISTS

Sudbourne has a 45 pupil per year intake, rather than 30 or 60 as in almost all other Lambeth schools. This means we must mix at least some year groups together. During this time of the year, the class lists for the next school year are being compiled. Class teachers and the Senior Leadership Team make class decisions taking in to consideration a vast number of factors when determining classes for the school academic year, including:

- **Dates of birth/age of child**
- Gender and ethnicity mix
- Spread of Additional and Special Educational Needs and Disabilities
- Ensuring that siblings are not in the same class
- Ensuring that a child is not with the same teacher too often and where possible looking at maintaining friendship groups,

The teachers and staff at Sudbourne Primary School are highly skilled and extremely well trained. Moreover they are very caring and decisions which have been made are in the best interest of all the children. The class teachers are highly sensitive to each child's needs and will work hard to make the daily learning experiences as enjoyable, positive and suitably challenging as possible regardless of class allocation.

It is very beneficial and healthy for children to have the opportunities to mix with other children, develop new friendships and experience a range of new social experiences. Within the school day, there will be many cross curricular opportunities for children to mix with other children outside their own class.

Combined with excellent academic teaching there is a structured PHSE (Personal, Health, Social, Emotional) programme that the school adopts which teaches children those vital life skills to enable them to manage change, form new friendships and flourish. Should you have any concerns please do see your child's new class teacher to equip them with any information you think may assist.
