Dear Parents/Carers,

Just before Christmas I mentioned in the newsletter about a new readiness to learn approach that we would be trialling in January. To support and encourage positive attitudes to learning. This is now in its third week. It celebrates when the children have excelled in their effort and attitudes with pupils seeing that they are either ready to learn, have a good attitude to learning or have an outstanding approach to their work. It also makes it clear when a child shows a less positive attitude and highlights if there is the need for a reminder of what is expected, the need for some time to think or a consequence. The aim of this is to make our expectations clear to the pupils. We will continue to review this approach and the impact that it has on pupils' learning.

We are also wanting to start musical instrument lessons for those pupils who wish to learn an instrument. We are organising for tutors from the Lambeth Music Service to come in and teach pupils in small groups. Pupils will have the opportunity to learn a stringed instrument such as the violin, a wind instrument including the clarinet or flute or learn how to play a brass instrument such as the trumpet. Please look out for a form that will come home in the book bags for you to indicate that your child would like to take up this opportunity.

You may have seen that to the rear of the school we are having new fencing built. This should be completed in the next ten days. As part of this project there will also be a new gate installed at the very front of the school bordering the pavement where we currently have the blue panelled gates.
