IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDING NOTICE

It has come to our attention that a number of children at Sudbourne are making videos at home and putting them on www.youtube.com—videos that are putting their safety at risk.

YouTube is supposed to be for users over the age of 13, due to the fact that the parent company, Google, collects and markets user data. It's not illegal for children under 13 to create social media profiles on sites that collect user data so long as the parent is aware of the account, knows user data is being collected, and has approved the child's account.

We are concerned that some children at Sudbourne are loading content to 'youtube' without parental approval, and are unwittingly providing information such as their name, where they live, the school they attend, their birthday, as well as identifying other children too.

At Sudbourne we have spent a lot of time talking to children about online safety, so they are aware of the risks. We encourage parents/carers also to talk to their children about these risks. This is a very useful weblink to use:
