PEDDLE MY WHEELS AT SUDBOURNE ON FRIDAY 11TH MAY 2018

The markets enable parents/carers to recycle unwanted bicycles, earn some money and in the process create affordable bike stock for others in their community and they are a great opportunity to pick up a serviced, affordable bike for your child (or yourself if you pre-order on our website). How it works -

- 08:00-09:30: drop off bikes for selling and we tag them with your details. These are added to the selection of children's bikes (and adult on request*) we bring along.
- 09:30-15:00: mechanic checks every bike and makes minor repairs where necessary. If the bike is beyond repair for what we are able to do on the day, sellers are notified and must collect at the end of the day, otherwise the bike becomes our property
- Sellers get a valuation of the bike sent via email with a link to a secure site for inputting their bank or PayPal ready for payment when the bike sells

- There is a 25% commission charge on all bike sales and this will be deducted once the bike sells
 - 15:00 - 16:30: market opens for people to buy bikes. We accept credit cards and cash
 - Unsold bikes are taken with us and sold at other markets and payment made once sold
 - If the seller wants their unsold bike back it is their responsibility to collect at the end of the day. We do not have time to notify sellers if their bike sells whilst the market is on
 - Any questions - please email info@peddlemywheels.com
- * Any adult looking for a bike for themselves should complete a 'Market Order Form' on our website at least 48 hours before the event and we will try and bring something suitable along.*

STAG BEETLES

Some junior pupils discovered five stag beetle larvae under an old tree stump in the junior play ground. They remain as larvae for between 3 to 7 years before turning into magnificent stag beetles.

Many years back, Sudbourne decided to help the stag beetle by placing lots of dead tree stumps to encourage their revival - it seems to be working.

Stag beetle numbers are in decline and are a protected species. They are now extinct in some countries. Conservationists such as PTES map sightings of them to monitor numbers. In South London, we are quite fortunate compared to the rest of the country as the numbers are rising.
