Once again we shall be providing Christmas parcels to those facing difficulties at this time of year. Our parcels will not only include our standard food but also a wide range of fresh fruit and vegetables, fresh bread and some basic items to enable those who wish to cook. As this is a busy day and people can wait a long time for parcels to be prepared, we are providing a whole range of entertainment and activities for children and their parents/carers. So while parcels are being prepared, families will be taken to **South London Theatre** which backs onto St Luke's church, for 2-3 hours of FREE activities to include films, crafts, storytelling and some refreshments.

Single people and couples will of course be looked after while parcels are prepared and refreshments will be provided in the main church for them.

To ensure we continue to provide all round support on 22nd December, we are also going to have 2 of our great advice workers from Centre 70 and Brixton Advice Centre on hand to give advice and support at this difficult time.
