## LOVE LAMBETH AIR – COMMUNITIES AIR QUALITY MONITORING RESULTS

As you may know, Sudbourne participated in a Lambeth air quality monitoring scheme last year. Please find below the results of the nitrogen dioxide (NO<sub>2</sub>) monitoring by diffusion tubes as part of this scheme. The overall results are pleasing since they suggest that nitrogen dioxide levels at the school are within national Air Quality Objectives which state that **annual mean concentration** of nitrogen dioxide should not exceed 40mg m<sup>-3</sup>.

### NITROGEN DIOXIDE MONITORING RESULTS

## COST OF BREAKFAST CLUB AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

We would remind you that the cost of after school clubs and breakfast club has increased from **September 2018**. We have been obliged to increase the price by £0.50 to cover costs. The revised prices are as follows:

£4 per child per session

£2 per pupil premium child per session

After school clubs for infants and juniors will now cost £40 per term (10 sessions) and for pupil premium children £20 per term (10 sessions). Please remember that all clubs must be booked and paid for in advance via [www.schoolgateway.com](http://www.schoolgateway.com)

If you are unsure about your child's eligibility for the pupil premium, please contact the School Office (0207 274 7631) who will be happy to assist you.

## COST OF SCHOOL MEALS

We would like to remind you that **the price of a school meal has increased by £0.10, to £2.40 per meal from September 2018**. Despite our best efforts the price of £2.30 no longer enables us to cover the total cost of the school meals, which is why we have had to raise the cost. This increase applies to children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 except those children who are eligible for free school meals. This does not apply to children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 since they are eligible for universal free school meals. If you are unsure about your eligibility for this, please contact the School Office (0207 274 7631) who will be happy to assist you. Incidentally, if your family would be entitled to free school meals but you have chosen not to make an application, there are many benefits to making an application and we would encourage you to do so. Again, if you would like to know more please contact the school office.

## SCHOOL DINNERS FOR TERMS 1 & 2

**School dinner payments should be made in advance online via School Gateway.**

Please find below information about school dinners this term. We therefore kindly ask that you log in to [www.schoolgateway.com](http://www.schoolgateway.com) to check your child's school dinner balance and make the relevant payment; many thanks to those who have already.

School Dinner costs:

- £2.40\* per day
- £12.00\* per week
- £81.60\* for this Term 1 (34 days: Tues 4<sup>th</sup> Sep to Fri 19<sup>th</sup> Oct 2018)
- £93.60\* for this Term 2 (39 days: Mon 29<sup>th</sup> Oct to Fri 21<sup>st</sup> Dec 2018)

Meal options can be changed at the start of term only. If you would like to switch your child's meal option from school dinners to packed lunches or vice versa, you **MUST** inform the school by completing and handing in a Change of Meal Option Form at the school office no later than Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September. **Until this is received, you will continue to be charged £2.40\* each day for school dinners.**

## SUDBOURNE SCHOOL UNIFORM

At Sudbourne School we take pride in the appearance of our children and so wearing the correct school uniform is something we ask of all our children. We would like to remind you of our uniform code so that this year we see all children in the correct uniform.

### Sudbourne School Uniform Code

- White top – polo shirt for infants (Reception to Year 2)
- White button shirt (long or short sleeved) for Juniors (Years 3 – 6)
- Grey trousers, shorts, skirt or culottes
- Grey socks or tights
- Navy blue V-neck jumper (cotton mix) with Sudbourne logo\*
- Navy and white gingham summer dress (optional)
- Navy hijab (optional)
- Black school shoes/sandals

**Please note: we DO allow children to wear black trainers (no logos) to school instead of black shoes, as we want to encourage children to be as physically active during playtimes as possible.**

- PE shorts/trousers: Navy blue\*
- PE T-shirt: Yellow\*
- PE shoes: Trainers: white or black only
