IMPORTANT INFORMATION: SCHOOL MEALS FOR YEAR 2 PUPILS WHO WILL START YEAR 3 IN SEPTEMBER 2018

If your child is currently in Year 2, they will have been receiving a free school meal regardless of their personal circumstances (as part of the government's Universal Free School Meals initiative for all infant school children). **Please note that this will cease when your Year 2 child begins Year 3 this September 2018, which will mean that you will be required to pay £2.40 per meal from September 2018 onward (unless you are eligible for means-tested free school meals),**

A form has gone home in the book bags of all Year 2 children this week, which should be returned by Wednesday 20th June. On this form, you must indicate if you want our child to continue receiving a school meal (at the costs of £2.40 per meal) or if you will provide them with a packed lunch each day. **Please complete this form regardless of whether your child is changing their current meal option or not, so we can update our records accordingly and ensure we order enough food from our school meal caterers.**

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

NB: Please note also that juniors **start at an earlier time of 8:45am** (and not 9:00am). They finish at the same time of 3:15pm.

SCHOOL DINNERS FOR TERM 6

We would like to remind you that school dinner payments should be made in advance online via School Gateway. The cost is £78.20* for this Term 6 (34 days: Mon 4th Jun to Thurs 19th Jul 2018)

Thank you to those parents/carers who have already paid.

If you would like to switch your child's meal option from school dinners to packed lunches or vice versa, you **MUST** inform the school by completing and handing in a Change of Meal Option Form at the school office.

Until this is received, you will continue to be charged £2.30* each day for school dinners.

INCREASE IN COST OF SCHOOL MEALS

We would like to inform you that **the price of a school meal will increase by £0.10, to £2.40 per meal from September 2018.**

Despite our best efforts the price of £2.30 no longer enables us to cover the total cost of the school meals, which is why we have had to raise the cost.

This change will not affect those who are entitled to free school meals through the Universal Free School Meals programme in Reception and in years 1 and 2. It will also not affect children in Key Stage 2 who are eligible for free school meals. If you are unsure about your eligibility for this, please contact the School Office (0207 274 7631) who will be happy to assist you. Alternatively, if you would prefer, you can email confidentially on admin@sudbourne.com

Incidentally, if your family would be entitled to free school meals but you have chosen not to make an application, there are many benefits to making an application and we would encourage you to do so. Again, if you would like to know more please contact the school office.

INCREASE IN COST OF BREAKFAST CLUB AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

We would also like to inform you that the cost of after school clubs and breakfast club will increase from September 2018. Again, we are obliged to increase the price by £0.50 to cover costs. The revised prices are as follows:

- £4 per child per session
- £2 per pupil premium child per session

After school clubs for infants and juniors will therefore now cost £40 per term (10 sessions) and for pupil premium children £20 per term (10 sessions).

If you are unsure about your child's eligibility for the pupil premium, please contact the School Office (0207 274 7631) who will be happy to assist you.

NURSERY APPLICATIONS FOR SEPTEMBER 2018 ENTRY

We still have some vacancies and so we are still accepting applications for admission to our nursery in September 2018. If you have a child that was born between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015, we **encourage you to register them as soon as possible. We also welcome applications for nursery aged children who do not have siblings already at Sudbourne so do share this information with family and friends too!**

30 hours free childcare

From September 2018, Sudbourne School Nursery will be offering the 30 hours free childcare provision, subject to eligibility and availability. To check your eligibility for 30 hours free childcare for your 3 – 4 year old, see: www.childcarechoices.gov.uk as soon as possible.

If you are not eligible for 30 hours free childcare, we can still provide the following, subject to availability:

- 15 hours free childcare (universal free entitlement) and/or
- Additional sessions (over and above 15 hours), **for which you will be charged.**

A variety of the attendance options we can offer is detailed our updated supplementary application form, as well as our updated nursery application form. If you are interested in a nursery place for your child, please complete and return both forms to the school office **as soon as possible**. Once received, we can begin to process your nursery application.
