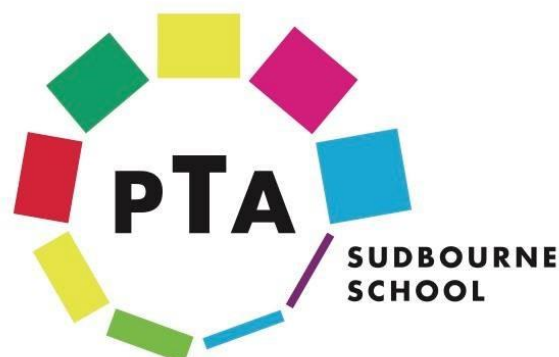

Sudbourne Primary School will soon be launching a brand new music department.

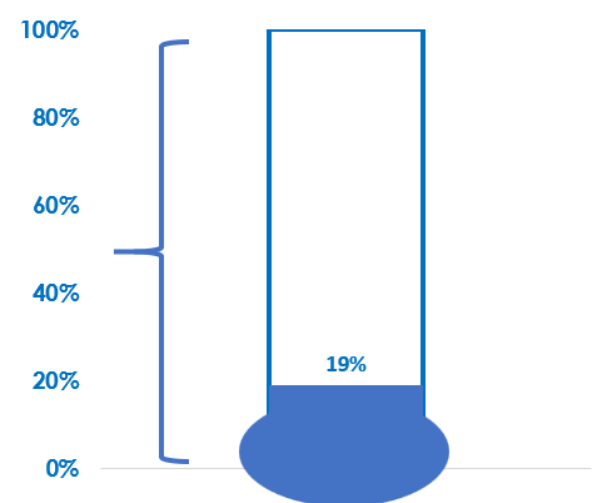

Please ensure that your children have a packed lunch full of healthy foods (**not to contain nuts** as an ingredient, sugary sweets or fizzy drinks) and ensure they have plenty water.

Due to the play scheme's Ofsted registration, we can only accept children from the 1st of September following their 5th birthday (school year 1 onwards).
