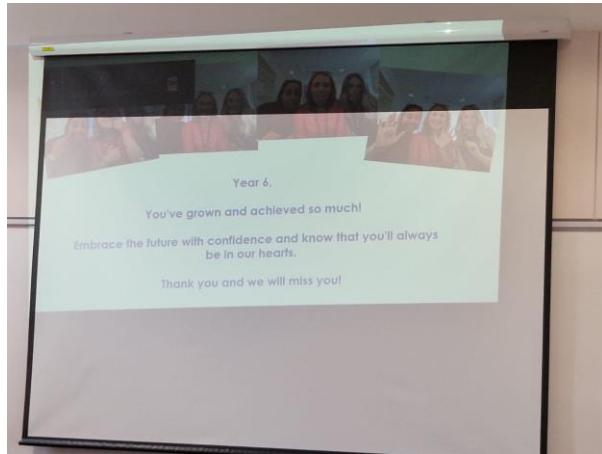






















## School Disco
