Childcare Voucher Payments (incl. Tax-Free childcare payments)


The school is no longer accepting childcare voucher payments or Tax-Free childcare payments, all clubs need to be booked directly.

step 1 on their website and then email/phone Arty Party, to let them know you want to pay with vouchers and they will complete the booking for you.


The Thursday Football Team training is available for all children in Years 3-6, there are no trials or 'tryouts' for children.







Dear Parents / Guardians,

Lambeth Council has introduced a School Street at Sudbourne Primary School during drop-off and pick-up times. This temporary closure aims to help reduce road danger on the road, improve air quality and increase active travel to school, creating a safer and more pleasant environment at the school gates.

Due to a delay in sign installation, the School Street was introduced on the 17th of November.

The School Street operates on Mandrell Road, Strathleven Road from the juction with Mauleverer Road and Mandrell Road, and Lambert Road between the juction of Glanville Road and Branksome Road, infroducing a temporary closure between 8:15-9:15am and 3:00-4:00pm, Monday to Friday during term time.
