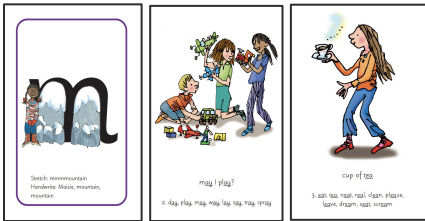

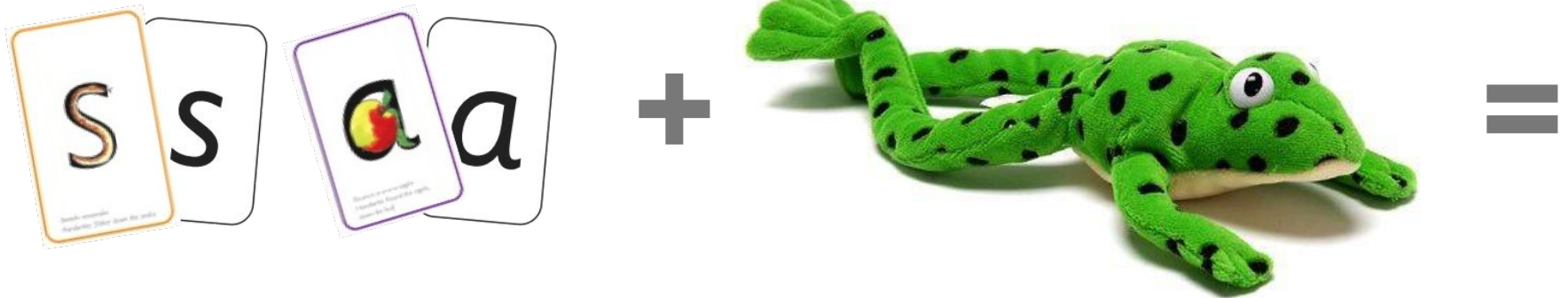

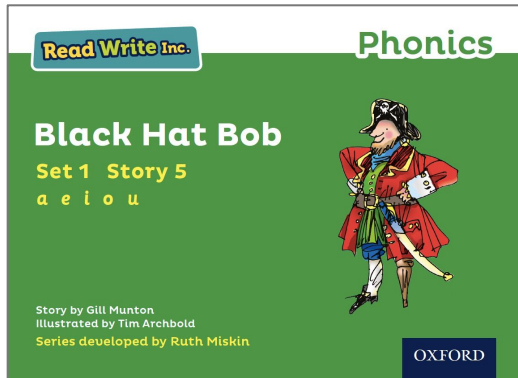

# Reading at home-Phonics Books

---

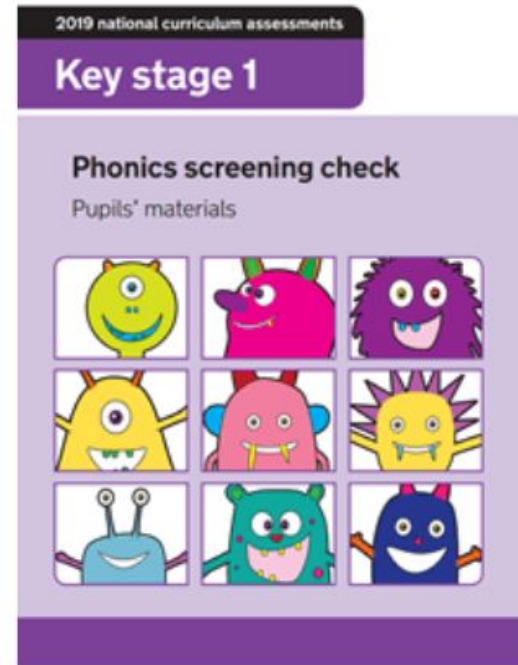
- 1.** Use pure sounds rather than letter names.
- 2.** Use Fred Talk to help your child to read and spell words.
- 3.** Choose a quiet time and give your child your full attention
- 4.** Explain the meaning of new words
- 5.** Talk about the text using open questions (look at front cover, predict what will happen, talk about pictures, retell the story)

# Phonics Screening Check

---

The phonics screening check is a **statutory reading check** that all year 1 children take during a particular week in June.

The check is designed to assess if each child has reached the age appropriate standard of decoding by the end of year 1.



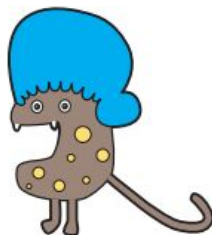
# Phonics Screening Check

---

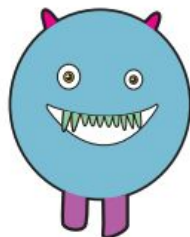
- Children read 40 words – takes between 2 and 5 minutes (Last years pass rate - 32)
- Given extra support and repeat the check at the end of year 2 if they do not pass

# Accelerated Reader Y2-6

Assess children's reading ability and then provides a ZPD (Zone of Proximal Development) - a reading range.

Children will then take home books of their choice within their reading range.

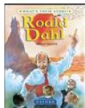
