Educational Psychologists are professionals concerned with the development, learning and social and emotional wellbeing of children and young people. Issues we can help you to think about include:

- Learning (e.g. how to help your child learn)
- Emotions (e.g. managing change, fears and worries, being away from friends/teachers)
- Managing routines/structures at home
- Resource seeking
- Signposting to appropriate services
