Friday 1 Apr


There may be other occasions in between these dates where it may be necessary for us to share additional information with you. Therefore, there may be other times when you receive extra news from us.

## Covid-19

If your child tests positive for Covid-19, please tell us straightaway. When you do inform us please tell us the date of their first day of symptoms and the date of the positive LFD test. When calculating their return to school date the guidance says that their isolation period starts and includes the day their symptoms started (or the day they had the test, if they did not have symptoms). Your child can stop self-isolating after 7 days if you do a rapid lateral flow test on days 6 and 7 of your self-isolation period and:

- both tests are negative
- your child did both tests at least 24 hours apart
- your child does not have a high temperature

If they do a rapid lateral flow test on day 6 and test positive, wait 24 hours before you do the next test. If your child gets symptoms while they're self-isolating, the 7 days restarts from the day after their symptoms started. If you need any support during a period when you or your child needs to isolate or are unsure about the date when your child can return to school please ask us.
